

Glasshouse Communications Cookie Policy

The website of Glasshouse Communications uses cookies and similar techniques (further herein: **Cookies**). They collect, store and/or share (personal) data via your browser in order to remember your preferences and to recognise users on a subsequent visit. In addition, Cookies enable Glasshouse Communications to collect information about the use of the services of Glasshouse Communications, its optimisation and to adjust it according to the wishes of users.

Disabling Cookies

Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default. However, you can reset your browser so that you no longer receive any cookies. This may result in you (partly) no longer being able to use certain services of Glasshouse Communications.

Cookies of third parties

Cookies of third parties are also placed via the platforms of Glasshouse Communications. In this case the cookie policy of the third party company will apply to the use of these cookies.

Functional cookies

On this website Glasshouse Communications uses Qtranslate. This functional cookie makes the language choice possible and is meant to allow the website to operate properly.

Analytical cookies

Glasshouse Communications uses Google Analytics, an analytical cookie to examine the use of the website of Glasshouse Communications and to optimise it on this basis. For instance such statistics enable us to examine how often and how long you visit the website of Glasshouse Communications and from which page you landed on the website of Glasshouse Communications. Google Analytics gives a randomly chosen ID to unique users in order to keep us informed of user, session and campaign data. The life of this cookie is two years.
